I. Access to the Venue

- I. Nearest subway station is "Kokusaikaikan Station", the terminal station of Karasuma Line, Kyoto city subway.



Fast Track

You can shorten the quarantine procedure at the arrival airport by installing the designated smartphone application MySOS and submitting the following 4 items before departing from your country:

- 1. Questionnaire
- Written pledge
- 3. Vaccination Certificate
- 4.A valid COVID-19 Test Certificate (image data)
 - Fast Track pre-registration has to be completed no later than 6 hours before arrival.
